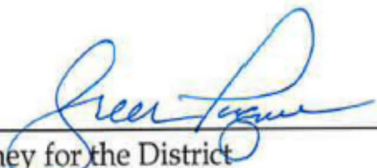
FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 5

 - iii. Briarwood Crossing, Section 21; and
 - iv. Courageous Trail Street Extension, Phase 1 paving facilities;
 - e. other engineering matters, including:
 - i. pond maintenance and repair; and
 - ii. update on wastewater treatment plant discharge permit renewal;
